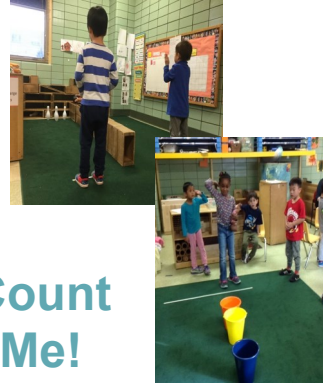
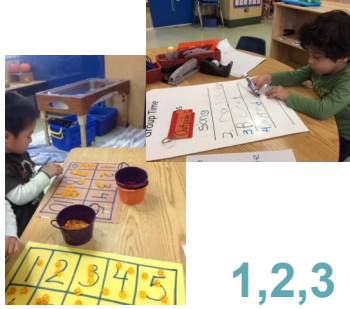

Math is all around us. This makes it easy and natural to explore mathematical concepts with our children in meaningful ways. By bringing attention to addresses on buildings, the numbers on a calendar, or count down at a cross walk; children can be engaged in conversations around numeration, sequencing, and developing number sense. Through playing card games like UNO or Go Fish we can support them in identifying and describing common attributes. While playing with blocks along side your child, concepts of geometry and spatial relations are formed. By allowing your child to participate in cooking they explore measurement and quantity. As parents, we can give our kids a head start in future academic success by helping them get comfortable with math concepts through simple life applications.

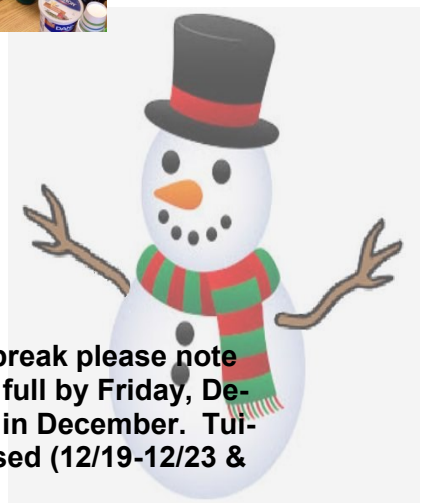


Congrats
