

In order to reopen as safely as possible, the UIC Children's Center has created an addendum to our parent handbook to address specific policies and procedures related to the Coronavirus Pandemic. The policies outlined in the *UIC Children's Center COVID-19 Guide for Parents* are effective beginning on July 13, 2020 and will be in place until further notice.

Additionally we ask that you agree to the following statements:

• If I bring my child to the UICCC, it is because everyone in our home is healthy and symptom free, with no known exposure to COVID19.

• Fever reducers will not be given to my child on any day of attendance, regardless of reason for fever reducer.

• If my child shows signs of illness while in attendance, I, or another authorized person, will retrieve my child as soon as possible, but no longer than 30 minutes from the time contacted.

• I will allow and wait for my child to be screened for signs of illness daily before leaving the premises.

• I will wait my turn to drop off or pick up my child, wear a mask while interacting with Center staff and other families, and practice proper social distancing while on program premises.

• I understand that the UICCC Staff will sign my child in and out, and will escort my child to their classroom and back to an authorized pick-up person at the end of the day.

• I understand this situation is fluid and subject to change per state, University, and program needs.

• I understand these policies are for the health and safety of all children, staff, and family members at the UIC Children's Center and I agree to follow them. If I do not, the UIC Children's Center will address concerns with me and that the well being of the whole program will be prioritized, which may include disenrollment from the program.
